**Subject: Compilations of Works by Different Persons, Families, or Corporate Bodies
(New 6.2.2.11)**

CCC thanks the Library of Congress for tackling this complex issue. CCC supports this proposal with the suggestions below.

Changes 1, 4 and 5

CCC supports changes 1, 4 and 5 as proposed by LC.

Change 2

CCC supports change 2, with the following small modification. At 6.2.2.11.1, use “commonly identified” in the first sentence because a compilation could be known by multiple collective titles, instead of “known.” This is in line with the changes proposed for 6.2.2.10 in the CCC response to 6JSC/CHAIR/15/rev/2.

6.2.2.11.1 Collective Title

If a compilation of works by different persons, families, or corporate bodies is commonly identified ~~known~~ by a collective title in resources embodying the compilation or in reference sources, apply the instructions at 6.2.2.4-6.2.2.5 in choosing the preferred title for the compilation. Record the collective title as the preferred title of the compilation.

Change 3

CCC supports change 3 as proposed by LC with a small revision to the reference to point to the specific instruction, 6.2.2.11.

6.27.1.4 Compilations of Works by Different Persons, Families, or Corporate Bodies

If the work is a compilation of works by different persons, families, or corporate bodies, construct the authorized access point representing the work by using the preferred title for the compilation (see 6.2.2.11).
